During the same time, he was an instructor of medicine at Harvard's Peter Bent Brigham Hospital. Rosenberg became board certified in internal medicine in 1976 and board certified in gastroenterology in 1977. He completed an executive master in business administration at the University of California – Los Angeles (UCLA) in 1996.

Rosenberg was educated at the National University of Mexico. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1965 and graduated magna cum laude from the university's School of Medicine in 1971. He completed his internship at Tulane University in New Orleans, Louisiana, and his residency in internal medicine at Tufts University in Boston, Massachusetts.
